# HELP STOP DISPLACEMENT PRO BONO OPPORTUNITY

- The Housing Rights Center is seeking volunteer attorneys to assist in preventing further displacement of tenants in Los Angeles County by working on Unlawful Detainer/Eviction cases in the Pasadena and West Covina Courthouse.
- With the assistance of the Housing Rights Center's staff attorneys, attorneys will be given the opportunity to represent tenants facing eviction.
- Attorneys can assist with representing a tenant from the inception of the case.
- Attorneys can limit their assistance to discovery preparation, motion writing, create pleadings, or appear for motions and arguments in court.
- Attorneys will work on pro bono basis and at no cost to HRC or the tenant.
- Attorneys will be required to take on a minimum number of assignments.
- HRC staff will provide attorneys training before working on any case.
- · Attorneys must have reliable internet and phone access.
